## CULTURE TIPS

**T**HE RAINS HAVE COME relatively early this year. With the soil still a bit on the warm side, conditions are perfect for weed seed germination. Preemergents are a blessing at controlling them. BUT they have to be applied before the seedlings emerge from the soil. Ideally preemergents are best applied just before a rain and before the seed germinates. If the seed has germinated, it must be cleaned out before its application. Look at the label to see what weeds the material controls. Preemergents are weed specific so select the brand that best matches the weeds you are trying to control.

Mulches are not recommended for use around your irises. They do hold weeds down but they also hold moisture which can foster rot problems especially in the spring.

Finish replanting your Pacificas now. The cooler weather and rain is very helpful at helping them get re-established. We rushed and pushed and got our replanting done just before the rains came. This rarely happens and will assure for minimal losses.

Also this is the last call to get any iris seed you have planted if you want germination in the spring. 🌸🌸 *Joe*
